Plant Veriety Protection in Vietnam


- Vietnam had PVP from 2000.
- The first Regulation on PVP was issued by Prime Minister in 2000.
- The National Seed Act was released in 2004 by Parliament and PVP is wholly contained in chapter 4.
- The Legislation on Intellectual Property Right (IPR) was issued in 2006 by Parliament; the PVP is presented in 4 chapters of the IPR legislation.
- Vietnam officially became the member of UPOV on 24 Dec. 2006 (the 63rd member).


Mandates of NCPAFT

- Carrying out field inspection and post control;
- Performing seed testing and certification;
- Setting up the manual for DUS and VCU testing, and seed standards for seed certification;
- 5. Testing for quality of crop product and fertilizer;

- Headquarter is in Ha Noi
- Subsidiaries:
 - Tu Liem station for testing of upland crops


